
Campus Character

International Student Experience Team

Our International Student Experience (ISE) team are a dedicated team of pastoral and support staff who act as a contact point for you should you have any questions, queries or suggestions before you arrive and whilst you study. They will help you prepare for your journey to Qatar, welcome you upon your arrival and support you throughout your time with us. With a dedicated team member, support is there for you where and when you need it.

Our team provides assistance across a range of issues such as orientation to the local area, homesickness, study difficulties, academic concerns, budgeting, health, personal challenges, family emergencies and more. This service is free and highly confidential.

Preparing to travel

Preparation is everything. Take time to find out before you travel about when you need to arrive, where you need to be and what you need to bring with you and it will make your journey and stay at university much less stressful.

What clothes you should pack

The climate in Qatar is generally sunny all year round, although the temperatures can be high in the summer months (June – September). You should bring clothes that you feel most comfortable in.

You may want to bring your national costume or something more formal to wear on special occasions but only pack what you can carry.

What else you should pack

You will have to carry your luggage and there are going to be size/weight restrictions, so only pack what is necessary.

Many of the items/brands that you know can be bought in Qatar from shops in many of the large shopping malls so you may not need to bring them from home, for example:

- Toiletries, e.g. toothpaste, shower gel, soap, deodorant
- Bedding you can request a bedding pack from Residential Services for a fee
- Kitchen utensils some kitchen utensils will be available in University accommodation
- Adapters for electrical equipment
- AA/AAA batteries



Travel Insurance

It's very important that you purchase travel insurance before your journey to Qatar. You should be able to purchase insurance through a travel agent or an insurance company in your home country.

Medical Insurance

We strongly recommend that all of our international students purchase their own private medical insurance before leaving home

Final Check-list

- Have you applied for and received your student visa or entry clearance to Qatar?
- Arranged your accommodation and made the advance payment if necessary?
- Arranged travel insurance, medical insurance, insurance for your property?
- Obtained any relevant medical records, including vaccination certificates, and have them translated into English if necessary?
- Checked restrictions on goods which can be brought into Octor?
- Packed your luggage and checked the weight to make sure that it doesn't exceed baggage allowance at the airport?
- Packed in your hand luggage: your passport, Student Visa, original documents, accommodation confirmation letter, a small amount of Qatari money for initial purchases, any medication that you need during your travels?
- Checked on the restrictions on the amount of money you are allowed to bring into the country?
- Packed a laptop or tablet to access course materials and complete assignments?



Travelling to Qatar

Qatar can be easily reached from every continent with flights offered by Qatar Airways and many airlines from across the globe. Hamad International Airport is conveniently located approximately 15 minutes from CUC Ulster.

When you arrive in Qatar

The "valid from" date on your visa is the date from which you can legally arrive in Qatar. We will be in touch with you a month before and will provide you with lots of information about our support options and transfers to your chosen accommodation.

Upon arrival at Hamad International Airport, you will be taken to your chosen accommodation. You will receive a welcome pack which will provide you with further instructions on your first few days and what to expect.

We arrange an airport pick up for all international students, including our Ahlan wa Sahlan (Hello) meet and greet service at the airport.

Admissions

How to Apply

We run two student intakes a year – September and January (check individual programmes)

Before applying, please check the specific admission requirements for the programme(s) you intend to apply for. Once you have gathered all the necessary evidence (see required documents list), complete the online application form or download an application form from our website.

We will send you a confirmation email once we have received your application and we aim to review your application and respond within 2 days. We may contact you to check your details or ask for more information depending on the requirements of the course.

If everything has been correctly completed, you will receive one of the following responses by email:

An Unconditional Offer


This means you have been accepted onto the programme and will be required to pay the registration fee in order to confirm your place.

A Conditional Offer

This means you will need to meet the conditions of the offer before you are accepted. This might be because you are waiting on exams or test results; that you need to achieve the necessary English Language level or something you need to provide before you are accepted. This information will be clearly stated in the offer letter you receive.

When you receive the offer letter, you will be asked to sign and return a form which confirms your acceptance. When you receive an unconditional offer, and to secure your place, you will be asked to make a minimum deposit payment against your tuition fees, of 3,500 QAR. A deposit payment does not signify that we will issue you with a Certificate of Acceptance for Studies (CAS). We view it as a sign of your commitment to study, and part of a staged admissions process.

The QR 3,500 deposit is also the registration fee payment that as per our fees policy is non-refundable. It can be refunded only if the condition of the conditional offer is not satisfied.





Required Documents

To apply for one of our programmes, you must upload, attach or include the following documents with your application:

- 1. Official Transcripts/ Grade Reports covering your last three years of high school as well as any further education you might have completed. If submitting manually, please place it in a sealed envelope with your name added. If further grades become available after you submit your application form, please submit them to our Admissions Office.
- 2. Photocopy of your Passport data page(s).
- 3. 2 passport-size photos.
- 4. Parent/guardian signed declaration on application form (if under the age of 18).
- 5. Accepted English Language test at required level.
- 6. Your CV for those programmes that require evidence of your work experience.

Sponsorships

If your fees will be paid by a sponsor (i.e Ministry or Company), then you will need to include a sponsorship letter from the organisation. If you will be receiving sponsorship from the Ministry of Administrative Development in Qatar, please provide a copy of this letter. If you will be receiving sponsorship from an organisation, the sponsorship letter should be submitted in English directly by the organisation, supplied in a sealed envelope or sent via email. If this document is not in English, it must be submitted along with an officially certified English translation.

Additional information

You may also wish to include information in support of your application, such as a letter of recommendation or a reference. The recommendation/reference letter may come from a Teacher/ Counsellor/ Employer and provide supportive information. Make sure to choose a candidate that knows you well and can inform us of your qualities, strengths and talents. The letter should be either in English, or Arabic, with an officially certified English translation.

PLEASE NOTE:

- All documents that are submitted become the property of City University College and cannot be returned to the applicant.
- If attaching documents through our online form, we only accept JPEG or PDF formats.

English Language Requirements

All our programmes are taught in English and therefore there is a requirement for you to be able to read, write, speak and understand the language. Every programme has a required level of English that you need to be at before you can join. If you do not have evidence of your English Test level, you will be offered the opportunity to sit our Password Test or be registered to complete an IELTS or Pearson PTE test.

If you do not have the required level, you will be offered the opportunity to join one of our presessional English programmes that will prepare you to meet the level you need. Alternatively, you can enrol on one of our English Language classes.
