Entry Requirements

Entry point: Foundation

- Be 18 years old or over upon completion of the International Foundation Programme.
- The successful completion of 12 years of high school education with a minimum of 50 % overall percentage
- Attain the equivalent of a minimum grade C, at GCSE level, in 5 subjects
- Attain an Academic IELTS overall score of 5.0 or equivalent (with no contributing band score of less than 5.0).
- Other international qualifications will be considered on merit for equivalency with the above requirements.

Entry point: Year 1

Completing of 13 years of education with three A levels Grade C, C, C

OR

IB Certificate with 24 points with at least 12 points at Higher Level

OR

Pearson BTEC Level 3 Extended Diploma level (MMM Profile)

• Academic IELTS overall score of 6.0 or equivalent (with no contributing band score of less than 5.5).

OR

- Other international qualifications will be considered on merit for equivalency with the above requirements.
